on pages 1-164 of *Alcoholics Anonymous*, 4th ed.**
(Bolding added for clarity)

Creator: 12 Occurrences: [KJV: Eccl 12:1; Isa 40:28; Isa 43:15; Rom 1:25; 1 Pet 4:19]

- p. 13 “. . . I would enter upon a new relationship with my **Creator**; . . .”
p. 25 “The central fact of our lives today is the absolute certainty that our **Creator** has entered into our hearts and lives in a way which is indeed miraculous.”
p. 28 “. . . all of us, whatever our race, creed, or color are the children of a living **Creator** with whom we may form a relationship upon simple and understandable terms as soon as we are willing and honest enough to try.”
p. 56 “For the first time, he lived in conscious companionship with his **Creator**.”
p. 68 “We never apologize to anyone for depending upon our **Creator**.”
p. 72 “We have been trying to get . . . a new relationship with our **Creator**, . . .”
p. 75 “We begin to feel the nearness of our **Creator**.”
p. 76 “. . . [W]e say something like this: “My **Creator**, I am now willing . . .”
p. 80 “. . . [B]etter to take those risks than to stand before his **Creator** guilty . . .”
p. 83 “. . . [A]sking each morning in meditation that our **Creator** show us . . .”
p. 158 “. . . [T]he lawyer gave his life to the care and direction of his **Creator** . . .”
p. 161 “They had visioned the Great Reality—their loving and All Powerful **Creator**.”

Maker: Two (2) Occ. : [KJV: Job 4:17; 32:22; 35:10; 36:3; Ps 95:6; Prov 14:31; 17:5; 22:2; Isa 17:7; Isa 45:9, 11; 51:13; 54:5; Jer 33:2; Hos 8:14]

- p. 57: “He humbly offered himself to his **Maker**—then he knew.”
p. 63: “Many of us said to our **Maker**, as we understood Him: ‘God, . . .’”

The Father: One (1) Occ.: [KJV: Matt 11:27; Mark 13:32; Luke 10:22; John 1:14, 18; 3:35; 4:21, 23; Acts 1:4, 7; 2:33; Rom 6:4; 15:6; 1 Cor 8:6; 15:24; 2 Cor 1:3; Gal 1:1, 3; etc.]

- p. 62: “God. . . . He is **the Father**, and we are His children.”

The Father of Light: One (1) Occ.: [KJV: Jam 1:17: “the Father of lights”]

- p. 14: “I must turn in all things to **the Father of Light** who presides over us all.”
